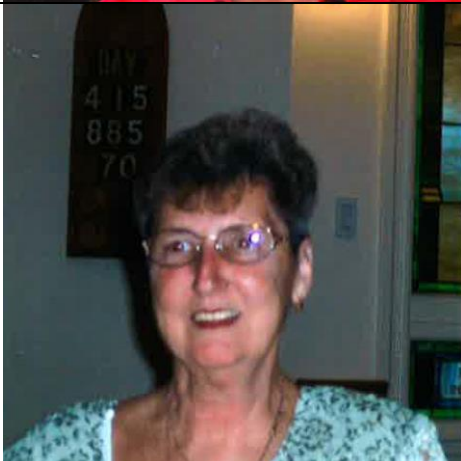


## **Susie Jablinske**
