ESSA: Protect Our Schools Act of 2017

- HB 978/SB 871: Protect Our Schools Act of 2017 (MSEA: SUPPORT)
 - HB 978: Gubernatorial Veto Override Chapter 29; House (90-50); Senate (32-15).
 - SB 871: Passed the Senate (31-15); no further action in House.

BUDGET: current formulas, school construction, BOOST, pensions, focusing on Kirwan

- HB 150/SB 170: Operating Budget
 - **Passed enrolled**; House (133-7); Senate (47-0).
- HB 1109/SB 1001: Fiscal relief for local boards of education for teacher pensions (MSEA: SUPPORT)
 - HB 1109: Passed and Approved by the Governor; House (139-1); Senate (33-14).
 - SB 1001: Passed House (136-2); Passed Senate (32-14)
- HB 696/SB 849: Prohibit discrimination at nonpublic schools receiving public money (MSEA: SUPPORT)
 - HB 696: heard 2/28 in Ways & Means; SB 849: heard 2/28 in Judicial Proceedings.
 - o Bills Failed
- HB 1072/SB 486: State Employees and Teachers Cash Balance Plan (MSEA: OPPOSE)
 - HB 1072: heard 2/21 in Appropriations; SB 486: heard 2/16 in Budget & Taxation.
 - o Bills Failed
- HB 516/SB 581: Study to advance pre-K recommendations to Kirwan Commission (MSEA: SUPPORT)
 - HB 516: Enacted under Article II, Section 17(b) Chapter 25; House (102-36); Senate (41-6).
 - SB 581: Returned passed; Senate (41-6); House (105-34).

LESS TESTING: testing cap, ELA moratorium

- HB 461/SB 452: testing cap on instruction time (MSEA: SUPPORT)
 - HB 461: Passed enrolled; House (140-0); Senate (46-0).
 - SB 452: Passed enrolled; Senate (47-0); House (139-0).
- HB 548/SB 667: ELA cannot be implemented without consulting PreK teachers (MSEA: SUPPORT)
 - HB 548: Passed the House (134-1); Passed the Senate (44-1).
 - SB 667: **Passed enrolled**; Senate (44-1); House (137-0).

CHARTER SCHOOLS/PRIVATIZATION: defending Maryland's charter school law; prohibiting privatization

- HB 878/SB 704: Public Charter School Act of 2017 (MSEA: OPPOSE)
 - HB 878: UNFAVORABLE from Ways and Means; SB 704: hearing canceled in EHEA.
 - o Bills Failed
- SB 618: Creation of a state-run "Achievement School District" (MSEA: OPPOSE)
 - SB 618: UNFAVORABLE from EHEA.
 - o Bill Failed

MSEA Legislative Priorities

TEACHER VOICE: adding teachers to the State Board of Education

- HB 590/SB 609: Add three teachers and two parents to the State Board of Education (MSEA: SUPPORT)
 - HB 590: heard 2/21 in Ways and Means; SB 609: heard 2/22 in EHEA.
 - o Bills Failed

COLLECTIVE BARGAINING: arbitration rights, community college organizing

- HB 497/SB 760: Create right for teachers to go to arbitration re: discipline issues (MSEA: SUPPORT)
 - HB 497: heard 2/14 in Ways and Means; SB 760: **Passed** the Senate (32-15); no further House action.
 - o Bills Failed
- HB 871/SB 652: Extend collective bargaining rights to community college employees (MSEA: SUPPORT)
 - HB 871: heard 2/21 in Appropriations; SB 652: heard 3/9 in Finance.
 - o Bills Failed

SPECIAL EDUCATION: parental consent, burden of proof and studies of special education resources

- HB 174/SB 710: Parental consent in IEP program (MSEA: Monitor)
 - HB 174: Passed enrolled; House (136-0); Senate (46-0).
 - SB 710: Returned passed; Senate (47-0); House (138-0).
- HB 1240: Amended to be two independent studies on special education resources (MSEA: SUPPORT) • HB 1240: Passed enrolled; House (138-0); Senate (34-0).

COALITION EFFORTS: earned sick, MD Trust Act to limit immigration enforcement at schools

- HB 1/SB 230: Earned sick leave (MD Healthy Working Families Act) (MSEA: SUPPORT)
 - HB 1: Passed enrolled; House (87-53); Senate (29-18).
- HB 1362/SB 835: Limit immigration enforcement at schools (MSEA: SUPPORT)
 - HB 1362: Passed the House (83-55); no further action in the Senate.
 - SB 835: **UNFAVORABLE** report from Judicial Proceedings
 - o Bills Failed

NBI ISSUES: suspension moratorium, restorative practices, whistleblower protection

- HB 425/SB 651: PreK-2nd grade suspension moratorium (MSEA: SUPPORT with Amendments)
 - HB 425: Passed enrolled; House (89-47); Senate (34-11).
 - SB 651: Returned passed; Senate (32-15); House (94-44).
- HB 1287: Commission on the School-to-Prison Pipeline and Restorative Practices (MSEA: SUPPORT)
 HB 1287: Passed enrolled; House (140-0); Senate (44-2).
- HB 1145: Whistleblower protections for school employees (MSEA: SUPPORT)
 - HB 1145: Returned passed; House (139-0); Senate (36-0).
