

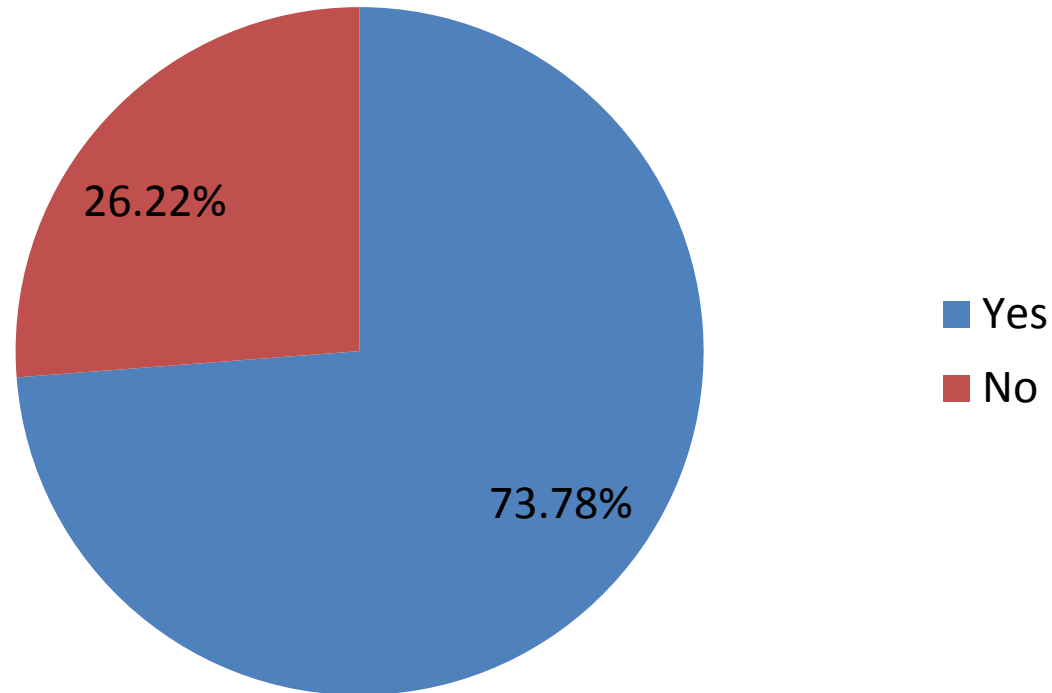
Teacher preparedness survey: New evaluation systems and Common Core

 - Statewide average was 2.7

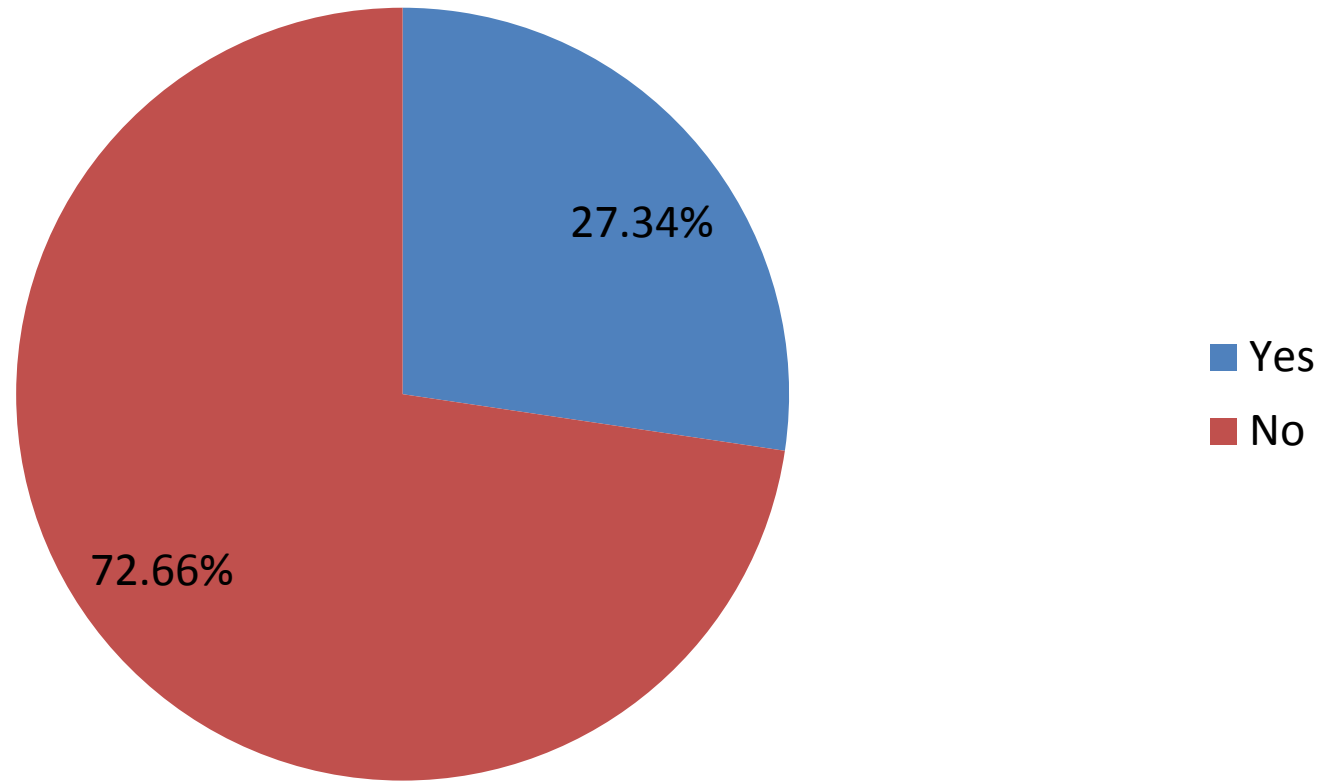

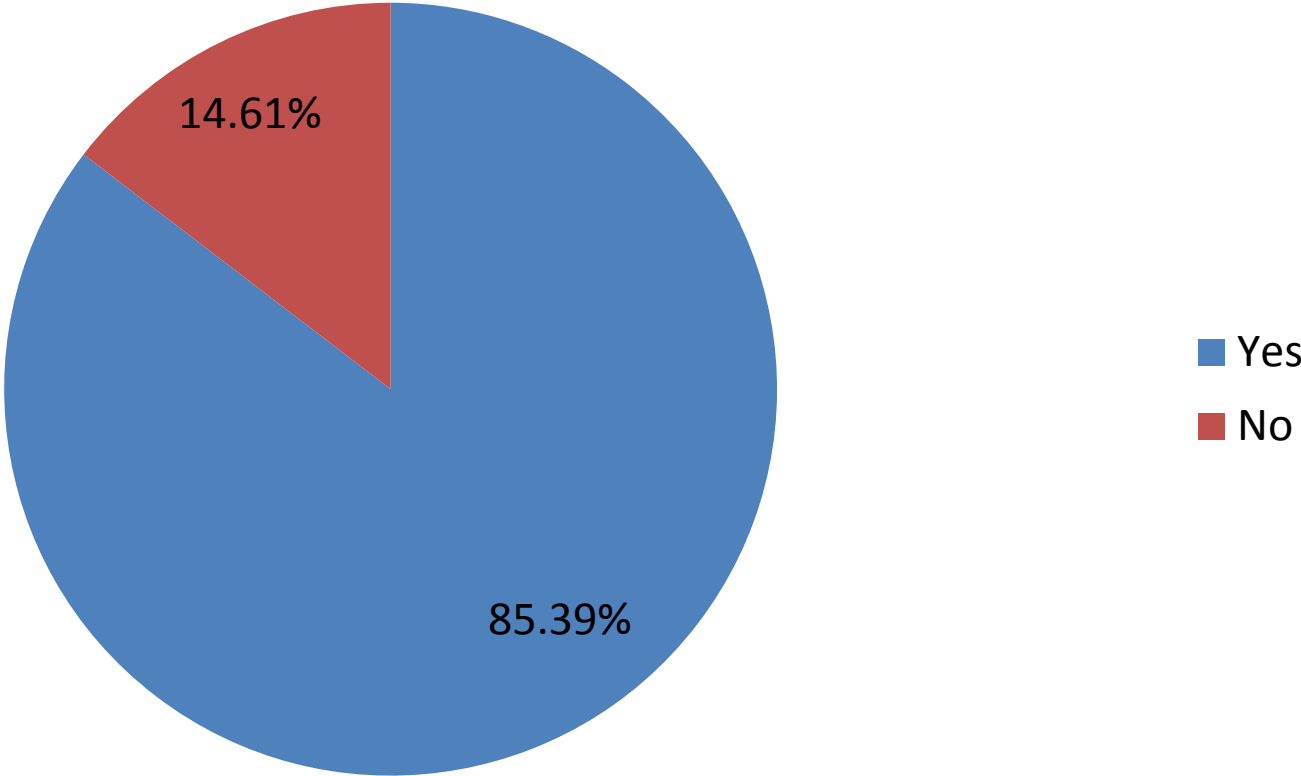

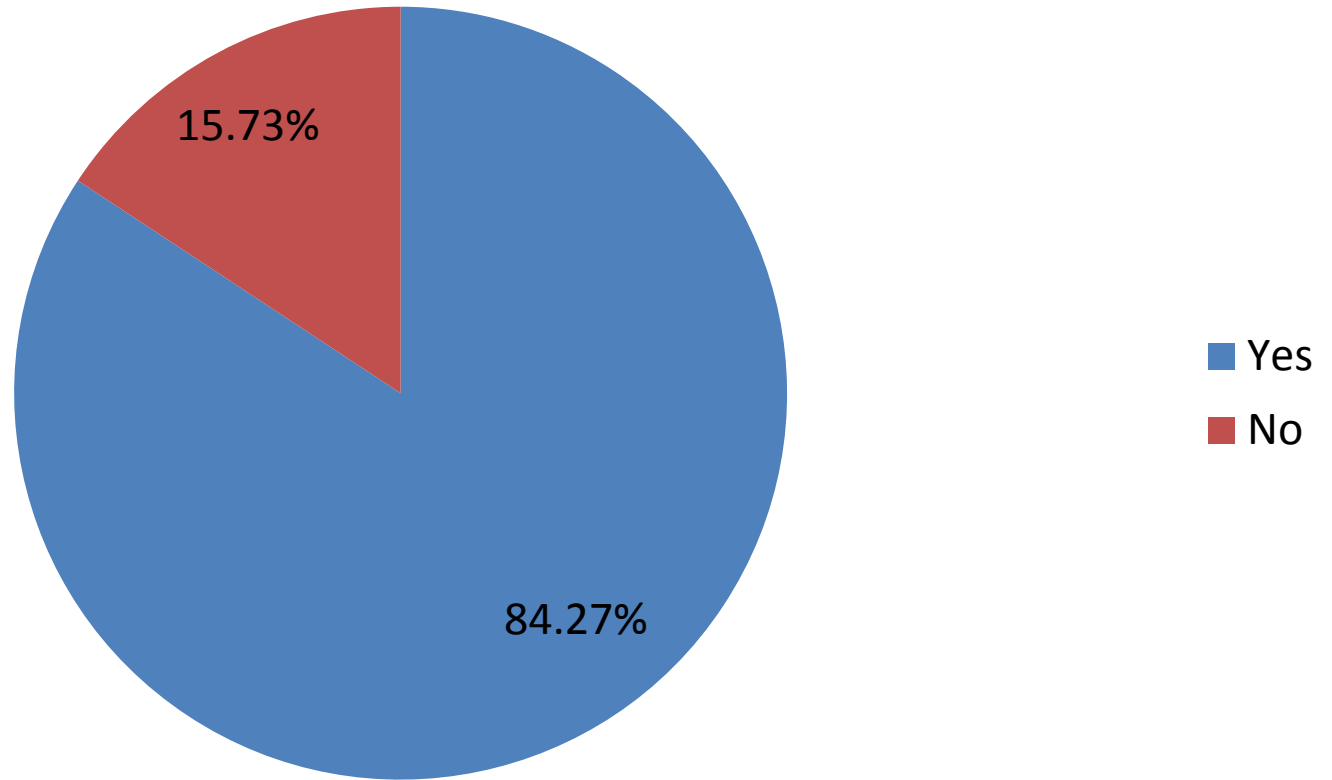

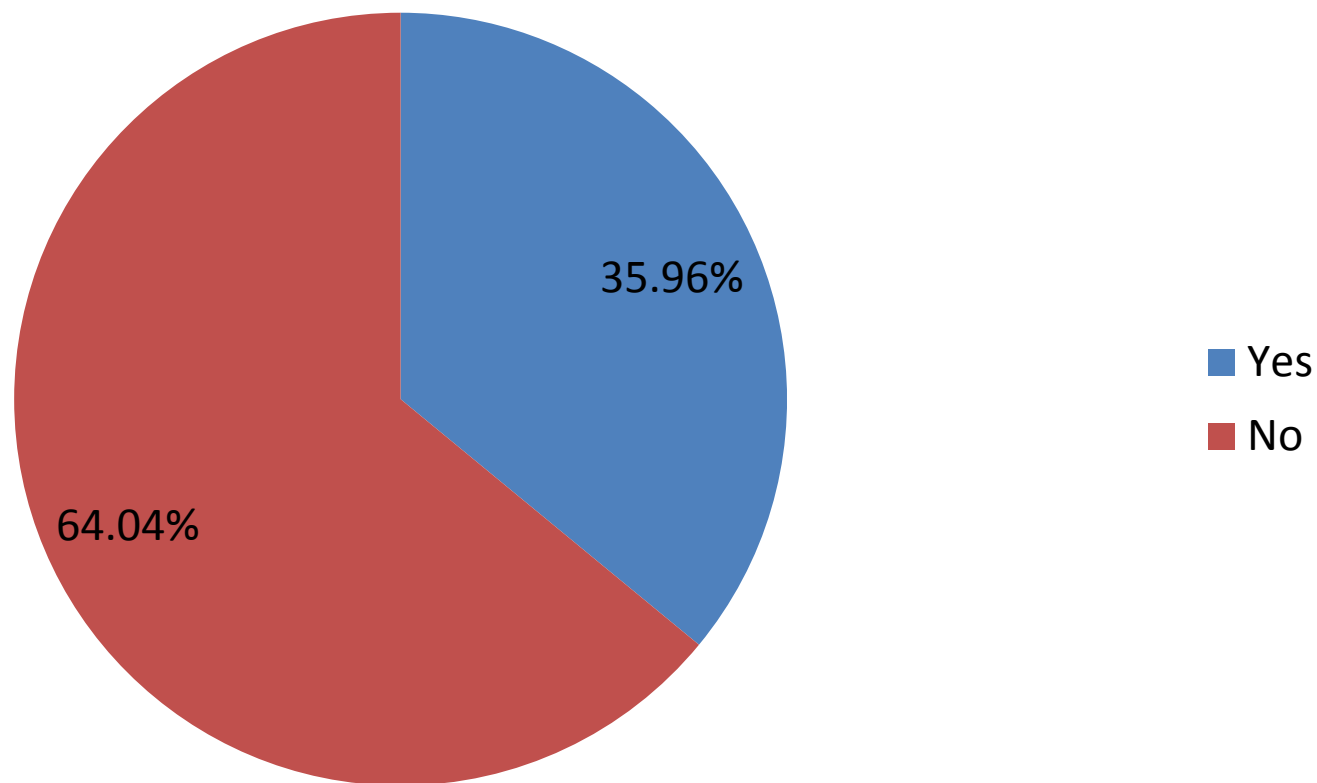

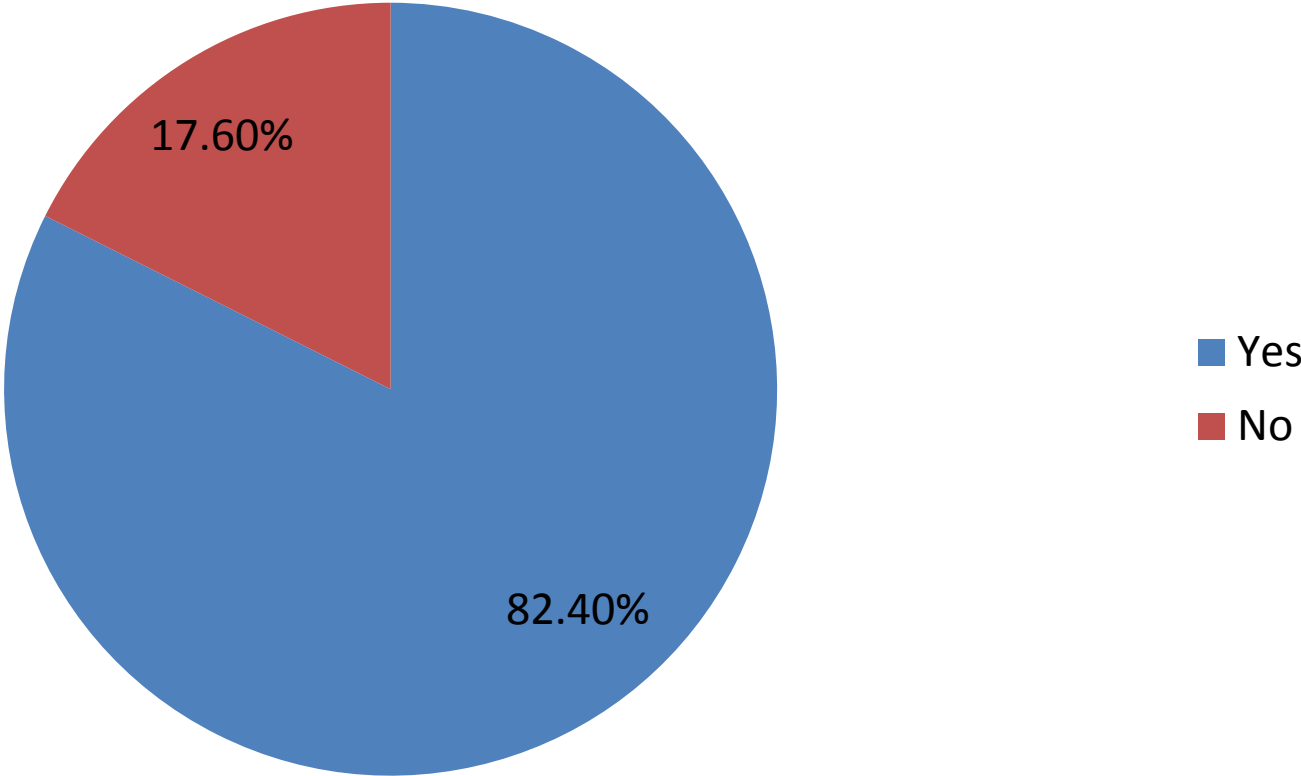
