Blueprint for Maryland's Future – Implementation 3rd Reader and Concurrence

The Blueprint is based on the findings of the Kirwan Commission and revises the state's school funding formula for the first time in nearly two decades. Over the next 13 years, the Blueprint calls for billions of dollars of new investment in Maryland schools that would expand career and technical education programs, community schools, and pre-k; provide more resources for students from backgrounds of poverty and students with special needs; increase educator pay; hire more educators; and create a new, more rigorous accountability system. Governor Hogan vetoed the bill, requiring an override in the next legislative session if it is to become law.

Third reader vote:

Senate (37-9), House (96-38)

HB 1

Built to Learn Act of 2020 3rd Reader and Concurrence

This \$2.2 billion initiative targets new construction and renovation projects in school districts across the state. Every district has examples of buildings with inadequate heat, rodent infestations, poor drinking water quality, mold, and other deplorable conditions. In areas where enrollment has grown, new classroom capacity is needed. Governor Hogan's veto of the Blueprint legislation effectively vetoed this legislation as well. An override of the Blueprint will reinstate this initiative.

Third reader vote:

Senate (45-0), House (125-9)

HB 1260

Historically Black Colleges and Universities Funding 3rd Reader

This legislation requires the Maryland Higher Education Commission to establish the HBCU Reserve Fund and the governor to include in the general fund budget \$57.7 million for the fund every year between fiscal 2022 through 2031, for a total of \$577 million. This legislation settles the decade-plus lawsuit between the HBCUs and the state of Maryland. Governor Hogan vetoed the bill, requiring an override in the next legislative session if it is to become law.

Third reader vote:

Senate (45-0), House (129-2)

SB 1028

Balancing the State Budget 3rd Reader

This legislation would finally give the General Assembly the same powers as 49 other state assemblies in that they can add money to a proposed budget item while staying within the Governor's overall appropriation, and would end the games of "fencing off" money and hoping the governor releases the funds to cover legislative priorities. This bill proposes a Constitutional Amendment that will need to be voted on in November 2020 and would not take effect until the first budget developed by the next governor (FY23).

Third reader vote:

Senate (30-15), House (95-39)

HB 1204

County Boards and Public and Nonpublic Prekindergarten Programs and Schools – Discrimination Prohibition

3rd Reader

This legislation would prohibit a local board of education or any other public or nonpublic education program that receives state funds from refusing enrollment or otherwise discriminating against any student or prospective student due to their race, ethnicity, color, religion, sex, age, national origin, marital status, sexual orientation, gender identity, or disability.

Third reader vote: House (95-38)

- MSEA POSITION: YEA on 3rd reader
